93 Points - The 2013 Endeavour Cabernet Sauvignon, a more limited Cuvée of only 995 cases, is meant to be their top Cuvée of Cabernet Sauvignon. It was aged 20 months in French oak prior to bottling. This is a serious, backward, rich, concentrated, firmly structured wine with a top-quality Bordeaux as an inspiration. Rich and deep, the wine has cedary graphite notes intermixed with black currants, cherries and loamy soil notes. This wine is full-bodied and should not be touched for another 4 - 5 years, but it is clearly capable of lasting 25 - 30+ years.
