2016 HERITAGE VINES ZINFANDEL – *Sonoma County*

WINE SPECTATOR April 2018	90 Points - Appealingly old-school, with zesty and briary raspberry, grilled anise and white pepper flavors that finish on a lively note. Drink now through 2022.
WINE ENTHUSIAST July 2018	90 Points - Blended with 20% Petite Sirah and 1% Primitivo, this is a thick, dense wine that offers smoky char beneath rich, full-bodied red berries and softly integrated oak. The finish has touches of mocha and sweet tobacco.

WINE SPECTATOR May 2017	92 Points - Smart Buy - Zesty and expressive, with jammy black raspberry and licorice aromas and supple, layered blackberry, toasty dill and pepper flavors. Drink now through 2026.
WINE ENTHUSIAST September 2017	Editors' Choice - Grown from cuttings derived from pre-Prohibition vines, this wine impresses in its burly red fruit and high-acid backbone. With 20% Petite Sirah and 1% Carignane, it's ripe and dense, with rich, concentrated highlights of mocha and leather.
CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE April 2017	90 Points - Very Highly Recommended - Medium to medium-dark purplish ruby; attractive, forward, moderately intense, spicy, peppery, raspberry and blackberry fruit aroma with a hint of black pepper; medium-full to full body; spicy, briary, red and black fruit flavors with bright acidity, peppery notes, and a hint of dark chocolate; medium-full tannin; lingering aftertaste. Ready and easy to drink now.

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
