### 2017 HERITAGE VINES ZINFANDEL – *Sonoma County*

CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE June 2019	<b>90 Points - Very Highly Recommended</b> - Medium to medium-dark ruby; attractive, ripe, cedary, dark cherry and blackberry fruit aroma with hints of cinnamon, nutmeg, dried herbs, and black pepper; full body; forward, rich, ripe, slightly jammy, dark cherry and berry fruit flavors with hints of anise, chocolate, and black pepper; full tannin; lingering aftertaste. Enjoyable to drink now or over the next two to three years.
WINE SPECTATOR May 2019	<b>91 Points</b> - Briary and vibrant, with zesty raspberry, toasted sage and cracked pepper flavors that take on richness toward polished tannins. Drink now through 2025.

WINE ENTHUSIAST July 2018	<b>90 Points</b> - Blended with 20% Petite Sirah and 1% Primitivo, this is a thick, dense wine that offers smoky char beneath rich, full-bodied red berries and softly integrated oak. The finish has touches of mocha and sweet tobacco.
