### 2017 SAUVIGNON BLANC – Dry Creek Valley

That said, this vintage of Dry Creek Sauvignon Blanc is still crisp, dry and racy, with flashes of citrus, melon and stone fruit flavors. -Marguerite Thomas
CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE July 2018	<b>90 Points - Very Highly Recommended</b> - Light yellow; attractive, assertive, fragrant, floral, grassy, lemon/lime, peach, and tropical fruit aroma with a mineral note, and a feint trace of oak; medium body; crisp, fresh, tangerine, guava, and passion fruit flavors with bright acidity; lingering aftertaste. A “pretty,” nicely balanced wine that’s very enjoyable to drink now and over the next year or two.
