90 Points - Year's Best US Zinfandel - This comes mostly from Vogensen's Barn Block - a steep, rocky, east-facing hillside planted in several passes beginning in 1997; the blend includes 12 percent Petite Sirah. It's a supple, approachable style, its purple fruit reaching some floral high tones, rounded out by a hint of sweet French oak. This is simple but pretty delicious, especially served cool out of a decanter with pork chops.
